The designs included the installation of six breakwater/groin structures and the placement of 24,000 cubic yards of sandfill to achieve a three-acre increase of the recreational beach area. Marina expansion designs were produced to accommodate Princess Cruises' larger 2,500 passenger ships and larger 200 passenger tenders.
